



SCENARIOS for 6 to 11 years old students

Context:

Wetlands are special places where land and water meet. Wetlands are helping people and nature in many important ways. They can give us things we need, like food and clean water, and they help protect us by soaking up extra rain, so floods are less likely. Wetlands also clean dirty water, but they can also be fun places to visit, play, and learn about animals. Many wetlands are being damaged or destroyed when people build houses, roads, or farms on them. When this happens, we lose the helpful things wetlands do for us and for the environment.

Select one of the scenarios below or go for another animal to describe the life in a wetland.

Scenarios:

You are a Pelican. It is April and you have just arrived in the Danube Delta. What is the first thing you want to do? What do you see around you?

Please create a picture book (min 10 pages) with you (the pelican) staying for the summer in the Danube Delta. At the end, add a box with 3 special facts about you and your favourite home.

You are an Otter. You love eating fish and playing. What else do you love to do? Who are your friends? Where is your "playground"?

Please create a picture book (min 10 pages) with you (the otter) living in your favourite playground, the wetland. At the end, add a box with 3 special facts about you and your home.
